# ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE FOR PEOPLE WHO DO NOT LIVE IN THE CA

Just come to Marie-Clauss-Straße 3, 69126 Heidelberg. Here you will find us. The first day of all workcamps starts on Monday at 8:30 a.m. with setup and breakfast. The workcamps always end on Sunday with departure in the afternoon. We recommend that you register for the whole period of a workcamp if it is possible for you. However, you can also indicate other periods in the registration.

After the workcamps we can refund (part of) the travel costs upon presentation of the purchase receipts. ## SUPPLY AND ACCOMMODATION

Drinking water, a container toilet, and showers are available on the premises. The camp is framed by three vegan meals daily - largely based on rescued food. If you have allergies or intolerances, we ask that you indicate this in your registration.

In addition, we ask all those who are already living on site in Heidelberg to also stay overnight in their apartments. For all other people we will create overnight accommodations: There is enough space for guests in our new building!

## CHECKLIST - WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

- Clothing suitable for work, sturdy shoes, work gloves (only if in possession)
- Sleeping bag or comforter as well as sleeping pad, air mattress, or similar for the overnight stay (if you do not already live in a new building)
- Some money for personal shopping, possible excursions into the city, drink donations, etc.
- Possibly portable music box for good mood at the workplace
- Things for personal use (card games, books, ...)
- A lot of fun and good mood!
